**Brian Skaife – Angling Anarchy
Capturing a Geneva Muskie...
And Some Memories**



Brian grew up fishing for panfish alongside his grandfather and dad on the Madison Chain of Lakes. His first trip to Canada to the Vermilion Bay region of Ontario opened the world of gamefish species, including muskies, and he never looked back. Targeting Bass, Pike, Walleye and Musky became the norm once Brian was able to drive and take the family boat around Southern WI. In 2010, the focus became primarily muskies, and that has been his target species of fish since.

As co-creator of Esox Assault Tackle bucktails and partner of Chaos Tackle for about 10 years, Brian has been deeply entrenched in the musky fishing community. He started Angling Anarchy YouTube channel in 2018 to not only showcase the baits that Chaos tackle was producing, but also to share his fishing adventures throughout the Midwest and Canada. He also enjoys sharing DIY boat project videos, as well as tutorials on how to use GoPros effectively and efficiently and Action Cameras so that they are not a burden while fishing. In August 2019, Brian started uploading a new video to his YouTube channel every Saturday at 8:30 a.m. and continues to do so. He has amassed a following close to 15K subscribers and has more than 3.5 million views.

Brian's full-time job is as a Chemist/Biologist for the City of Janesville at the Wastewater Treatment Facility. His job there keeps him closely connected to the different issues surrounding surface water quality in the greater Southern Wisconsin region.

Brian's talk will focus on how to get that GoPro that you may have, collecting dust in a corner, out in the boat so that you can easily and effectively capture special moments that you may encounter in your own fishing adventures no matter what kind of fish you are targeting. He will also talk about the emerging musky fishery on Lake Geneva, and how and where to target them.
